This seminar consists of full days of riding and can be very challenging to both horse and rider. Riders and horses should be in shape in order to get the most out of the training.

Bring a lunch for Saturday and pizza will be provided for Sunday.

Water and soda will be provided for both days.

If traveling and would like to stall your horse at the arena overnight for \$20.00 contact Tari Ryan.

If you have a fully contained trailer/camper and need a place to stay contact Tari Ryan.

Safety - Police Horse Pros takes safety very seriously. Boots or shoes with heels and approved equestrian helmet (while mounted) are mandatory. Horses must be saddled, no bareback riding or bareback pads are allowed. Participants must be over 18 years of age – but exceptions may be made on a case by case basis.

Horses - This clinic is not for green broke horses. While horses of all breeds and ages can be successful, they must be well broke to the saddle and bridle. (No horses may be ridden in halters only.) All participants must ride their horses through the courses - Police Horse Pros never allow riders to lead a horse through an obstacle.

DIRECTIONS
